**Detaining Adolescents - How Do Different Jurisdictions Manage Risk
Behaviours in Adolescents.**

Abstract text up to 15 lines in English:

Background - Around the world, adolescents are detained under mental health, welfare or justice legislation for risk behaviours. However, the legislation, types of secure placement, restrictive practice, reasons for detention, vary across jurisdictions. Comparing practice and learning from each other will help professionals working with adolescents showing risk behaviours.

Workshop presenters - Members of an International Research Collaboration investigating secure settings and needs for secure care for young people

Workshop outline- In this workshop, we will discuss various vignettes describing complex scenarios seen in young people around the world, that may lead to detention in secure settings. Discussion in the workshop will facilitate discussion with participants of how different countries would manage the care of young people in these complex situations. This will enable us all to develop greater understanding of practice around the world and learn from good practice in other jurisdictions.
