The Quadrifocal Brain: Practical Impacts by a New Theoretical Model

The concept of a quadrifocal brain has first been introduced by Julius Kuhl (Germany). Dealing with new models involving psychological, neurophysiological, medical, and neuropsychological aspects led to a new conception of psychic dynamics mainly based on the impact of emotional proceedings. It's combination with older medical theories in handwriting psychology not only improves and, hence, legitimates these very theories by creating new and very useful aspects by bringing new light in important phenomena in the handwriting movement, but may explain better and lead more directly to the specific problem focus in psychotherapy; as well it opens up new ways of mobilizing effectively the available resources
