This Symposium addresses the important and topical questions of women's mental health (WMH).

We will discuss the issue with a compilation of speakers from different countries, and several international bodies – the WMH Section of WPA; the Women, Gender and Mental Health Section of EPA; and The International Association of Women's Mental Health (IAWMH) – will be presented.

Prof. Unaiza Niaz (Pakistan) will provide a comprehensive view of her substantial professional experience in promoting women's mental health in adversity. She will elaborate on the issue, aiming to contribute to improving women's and society's mental health.

Dr. Francia Campos (Colombia/Japan) will examine the partnerships of psychiatric professionals with those in adversity, the opportunities and obstacles within the mental health system in the case of special populations, and its impact on the mental health outcome of women.

Dr. Ekin Sönmez Güngör (Turkey) will describe the issue of intimate partner violence and its health consequences, as well as the social and economic consequences of the Covid-19 pandemic, which also impacts the compromised mental well-being of many individuals. Dr. Natalia Semenova and Dr. Aleksandra Ilgizova will focus on the issue of multiple roles, role conflict, and women's mental health. The problem is illustrating these roles' interplay through a particular case study of a woman with a mental disorder.
