Gendering, trans-intersexuality, hetero-homosexuality, queer life: the current discussions show then ever people's need for a holistic gender identity. Sigmund Freud already postulated human bisexuality, which he referred to his drive theory. Alfred Adler coined the term „mental hermaphroditism“, although he remained stuck in his one-sided theory of neuroses. Starting from and distinguishing itself from these early approaches, the lecture deals with the history of the male and female principles, as well as the understanding of androgyny in Günter Ammon's dynamic psychiatry. The latter, with its human structural approach and holistic view of humanity, goes far beyond the usual understanding of gender roles.
